Current Appropriations Clause in Bill

The bill includes an appropriation clause that appropriates a total of:

- \$30,000 cash funds from the Department of State Cash Fund to the Department of State for FY 2021-22. This provision also states that the Department may expend this funding through FY 2022-23.
- \$14,309 cash funds from the Department of State Cash Fund to the Department of State for FY 2022-23. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that

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the Department will require an additional 0.3 FTE.
