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<b>Summary of Fiscal Impact:</b>	<b>No fiscal impact.</b> The bill aligns state statute with federal law regarding certain areas of Medicaid eligibility. It has no impact on state or local revenue or expenditures.
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<b>Appropriation Summary:</b>	No appropriation is required.
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<b>Fiscal Note Status:</b>	The final fiscal note reflects the enacted bill.
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## Summary of Legislation

This bill aligns state income eligibility requirements with federal law for children and pregnant women under the Child Health Plan Plus (CHP+) and Medicaid programs.

## Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

The Department of Health Care Policy and Financing currently determines eligibility for CHP+ and Medicaid based on federal eligibility requirements; therefore, no increase in state expenditures is required and the bill has no fiscal impact.

## Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor and took effect March 24, 2022.
