Bill Topic: NEIGHBORHOOD YOUTH ORGANIZATIONS

Summary of Fiscal Impact: **No fiscal impact.** This bill makes several changes in the operations and regulation of neighborhood youth organizations. It is assessed as having no fiscal impact on state and local governments.

Appropriation Summary: No appropriations are required.

Fiscal Note Status: The fiscal note reflects the introduced bill.

Summary of Legislation

This bill makes several changes in the operations and regulation of neighborhood youth organizations (NYOs), including:

- lowering the age limit to five years old for youths wishing to join a NYO;
- allowing NYOs to track youths' arrival and departure times for specified purposes;
- requiring NYOs to offer programs and services that are evidence- or research-based to support youths' various needs, with a particular focus on low-income families; and
- requiring that NYOs operate out of a facility specifically owned, leased, or granted use to the organization.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

The bill updates the statute concerning NYOs to codify current practices and eliminate outdated language. This results in no change to state or local government revenue or expenditures, and the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect upon signature of the Governor, or upon becoming law without his signature.
