Bill Topic: BROADBAND PROVIDER'S USE OF PUBLIC RIGHTS-OF-WAY

Summary of Fiscal Impact: No fiscal impact. The bill codifies the requirement that the Department of Transportation facilitate non-government access to public rights of way for the deployment of broadband.

Appropriation Summary: No appropriation is required.

Fiscal Note Status: This revised fiscal note reflects the reengrossed bill.

Summary of Legislation

By means of Executive Order D 2022 009, the Governor has directed the Department of Transportation (CDOT) to develop an electronic application and other structures to facilitate non-governmental access to public rights of way and fiber lease or swap for the deployment of broadband.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

As the bill codifies the requirement that CDOT develop an electronic application and other structures to allow non-governmental entities to request access to public rights of way for the deployment of broadband, it is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect 90 days following adjournment of the General Assembly sine die, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
