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<b>Summary of Fiscal Impact:</b>	<b>No fiscal impact.</b> The bill updates terms in the statute that regulates health professionals. The bill has no fiscal impact.
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<b>Appropriation Summary:</b>	No appropriation is required.
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<b>Fiscal Note Status:</b>	The fiscal note reflects the introduced bill, as recommended by the Statutory Revision Committee.
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## Summary of Legislation

The bill updates language in Article 30 of Title 12 C.R.S., which regulates health care occupations and professions, to refer to “regulators” instead of “boards.”

## Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

The bill updates terminology and does not change how the Department of Regulatory Agencies regulates health professionals, nor does it change the regulations for health care professionals. Therefore, the bill does not impact state or local government revenue or expenditures and has been assessed as having no fiscal impact.

## Effective Date

The bill takes effect 90 days following adjournment of the General Assembly sine die, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
