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**Bill Topic:** REVISOR'S BILL

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**Summary Fiscal Impact:** **No fiscal impact.** The bill amends or repeals obsolete, unclear, or conflicting laws. It is assessed as having no fiscal impact on state or local government as it makes only technical changes.

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**Appropriation Summary:** No appropriation is required.

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**Fiscal Note Status:** The fiscal note reflects the introduced bill, which was recommended by the Committee on Legal Services.

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## Summary of Legislation

This bill amends or repeals obsolete, unclear, or conflicting laws. The bill also clarifies statutory language, but does not change the intent or meaning of these sections of law. The appendix of the bill explains the reasons for each change

## Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

The bill makes technical changes to laws that do not impact the revenues, expenditures, or workload of any state agency or local government. For this reason, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

## Effective Date

The bill takes effect 90 days following adjournment of the General Assembly sine die, assuming no referendum petition is filed, except that Section 99 takes effect only if HB 22-1040 becomes law and Section 100 takes effect only if HB 22-1211 becomes law.
