The bill requires legislative leadership to consult with legislators before assigning sponsorship to sunset bills. It minimally increases state workload beginning in FY 2022-23.

Appropriation Summary: No appropriation is required.

Fiscal Note Status: The fiscal note reflects the introduced bill.

Summary of Legislation

Under current law, the Speaker of the House of Representatives or the Senate President must assign sponsorship of sunset bills, depending on the year. The bill requires them to consult with their chamber's minority leader and receive permission from the sponsor before assigning sponsorship.

State Expenditures

The bill minimally increases workload in the Legislative Department for determining bill sponsorships. No change in appropriations is required.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect 90 days following adjournment of the General Assembly sine die, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
