## A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING THE CREATION OF A NAVIGATOR PROGRAM TO PROMOTE 102 APPRENTICESHIPS TO HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS.

## **Bill Summary**

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. The bill directs the office of future of work (office) in the department of labor and employment to create an apprenticeship navigator pilot program (program) with 2 full-time apprenticeship navigators, with each apprenticeship navigator assigned to a different school district selected by the office. The purpose of the program is to increase awareness of registered apprenticeship programs among

graduating high school students in the selected school districts.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

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The bill also directs the office to promote apprenticeship programs to high school students by creating and maintaining a web-based job board of apprenticeships and incorporating apprenticeships in the state's career planning tools.

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, add part 7 to article 3 83 of title 8 as follows: 4 PART 7 5 APPRENTICESHIP NAVIGATOR PILOT PROGRAM 6 **8-83-701. Definitions.** As used in this part 7, unless the 7 CONTEXT OTHERWISE REQUIRES: 8 (1) "DEPARTMENT" MEANS THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND 9 EMPLOYMENT CREATED IN SECTION 24-1-121. 10 (2) "OFFICE" MEANS THE OFFICE OF FUTURE OF WORK CREATED IN 11 SECTION 8-77-110. 12 (3) "PROGRAM" MEANS THE APPRENTICESHIP NAVIGATOR PILOT 13 PROGRAM CREATED BY THE OFFICE OF FUTURE OF WORK IN SECTION 14 8-83-702. 15 (4) "RURAL SCHOOL DISTRICT" MEANS A SCHOOL DISTRICT THAT 16 THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION DETERMINES IS RURAL, BASED ON THE 17 GEOGRAPHIC SIZE OF THE SCHOOL DISTRICT AND THE DISTANCE OF THE 18 SCHOOL DISTRICT FROM THE NEAREST LARGE, URBANIZED AREA. 19 (5) "SCHOOL DISTRICT" MEANS A SCHOOL DISTRICT AUTHORIZED 20 BY SECTION 15 OF ARTICLE IX OF THE STATE CONSTITUTION AND 21 ORGANIZED PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 30 OF TITLE 22. "SCHOOL DISTRICT" 22 ALSO INCLUDES A BOARD OF COOPERATIVE SERVICES CREATED PURSUANT 23 TO ARTICLE 5 OF TITLE 22 IF IT IS OPERATING A PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL.

20	<b>SECTION 2.</b> In Colorado Revised Statutes, <b>amend</b> 8-77-110 as
21	follows:
22	<b>8-77-110.</b> Office of future of work - study - report. (1) The
23	office of future OF work in the department of labor and employment,
24	created by executive order B 2019 009, shall, within the scope of the
25	executive order, study unemployment assistance as part of its study on the
26	modernization of worker benefits and protections.
27	(2) On or before January 15, 2021, the office of future work shall

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1	submit an initial report as directed by executive order B 2019 009 to the
2	governor and to the business, labor, and technology committee of the
3	senate and the business affairs and labor committee of the house of
4	representatives, or their successor committees.
5	SECTION 3. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 8-83-601, amend (7)
6	as follows:
7	<b>8-83-601. Definitions.</b> As used in this part 6:
8	(7) "Office" means the office of future OF work described in
9	section 8-77-110.
10	<b>SECTION 4.</b> In Colorado Revised Statutes, 22-2-136, amend (1)
11	as follows:
12	22-2-136. Additional duty - state board - individual career and
13	academic plans - standards - rules. (1) (a) On or before February 1,
14	2010, The state board shall promulgate rules pursuant to the "State
15	Administrative Procedure Act", article 4 of title 24, to establish standards
16	for individual career and academic plans for students enrolled in the
17	public schools in the state.
18	(b) An individual career and academic plan must be designed to
19	assist a student and the student's parent or legal guardian in exploring the
20	postsecondary career and educational opportunities available to the
21	student, INCLUDING APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAMS REGISTERED THROUGH
22	THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF LABOR'S OFFICE OF APPRENTICESHIP
23	OR A STATE APPRENTICESHIP AGENCY RECOGNIZED BY THAT OFFICE;
24	aligning course work and curriculum; applying to postsecondary
25	education institutions; securing financial aid; and ultimately entering the
26	workforce. As part of the process of establishing the individual career and
27	academic plan, the student and the student's parents must be made aware

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of the importance of completing the free application for federal student aid or the Colorado application for state financial aid, or successor forms for accessing federal and state financial aid, and be provided help in completing the forms, if requested.

SECTION 5. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in November 2024 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.

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
