CONCERNING THE REQUIREMENT THAT A STORE USE FEES COLLECTED FROM SINGLE-USE BAGS TO PURCHASE CERTAIN ITEMS FOR THE STORE.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

**SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25-17-505, **amend** (3)(d)(I) introductory portion; and **add** (3)(d)(III) as follows:

- 25-17-505. Carryout bag fee disposition of money repeal.
  (3) In providing carryout bags for a fee pursuant to this section, a store shall:
- (d) (I) On a quarterly basis, starting April 1, 2024, remit from the total amount of carryout bag fees collected in the previous quarter the amount that is owed to the municipality or county:

(III) IF A MUNICIPALITY OR COUNTY HAS NOT ESTABLISHED A PROCESS TO ACCEPT FEES REMITTED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (3)(d)(I) OF THIS SECTION, THE STORE SHALL RETAIN AND USE THE PORTION OF THE FEES COLLECTED IN THE PREVIOUS QUARTER THAT WOULD HAVE BEEN REMITTED TO THE MUNICIPALITY OR COUNTY FOR THE PURPOSES LISTED IN SUBSECTIONS (1)(a)(I)(B) AND (2)(a)(I)(B) OF THIS SECTION AND TO PURCHASE REUSABLE BAGS.
