CONCERNING THE TRANSFER OF MONEY FROM THE STATE EMPLOYEE
RESERVE FUND TO THE GENERAL FUND TO FUND MONTHLY HOUSING
STIPENDS FOR DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS STAFF.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-50-104, **add**
(1)(j)(III)(F) as follows:

**24-50-104. Job evaluation and compensation - state employee
reserve fund - created - study - report - definitions - repeal.** (1) **Total
compensation philosophy.** (j) (III) (F) ON JULY 1, 2023, THE STATE
TREASURER SHALL TRANSFER FOUR MILLION NINE HUNDRED THIRTEEN
THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE DOLLARS FROM THE FUND TO THE
GENERAL FUND.

SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
