# A BILL FOR AN ACT

### 101 CONCERNING THE CREATION OF "JURY APPRECIATION DAY".

### **Bill Summary**

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. The bill establishes an annual jury appreciation day on September 5 of each year.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. Legislative declaration. (1) The general assembly

1 finds and declares that:

2 (a) The jury system is a cornerstone of Colorado's form of
3 government and is therefore a matter of statewide concern;

4 (b) The jury service system is important to democracy because of
5 the unbiased, impartial viewpoints that can be derived from our citizens
6 who are selected from a wide cross-section of society;

7 (c) Serving on a jury promotes civic participation, as it is the most
8 direct and impactful way for citizens to participate in and connect to the
9 state's system of government;

(d) Jury service is a civic duty, and jurors make important
sacrifices regarding personal time, family, and professional life to devote
the necessary time to serve as jurors;

13 (e) Jury service is important, and it benefits all residents of the14 state;

(f) Our country's founders included the right to be tried by a jury
of our peers, a safeguard against tyranny, in the Bill of Rights;

17 (g) The first jury trial in the American colonies was held in18 Plymouth, Massachusetts, in 1630; and

(h) September fifth commemorates a 1670 jury trial in which a
jury acquitted William Penn, who was facing the death penalty after
preaching to Quakers, a banned religion in England at the time. The jury
reached their verdict despite intimidation and imprisonment by the
English trial court, and the jury's independence and integrity were upheld
by an appellate court.

(2) The general assembly further finds and declares that:

26 (a) A trial by a jury of one's peers in both civil and criminal cases
27 has historically been part of the American legal system's promise of

impartial justice, but in Colorado's history, not all citizens have been able
 equally to serve on juries due to race, ethnicity, or gender;

3 (b) Racial disparities in jury pools have given some Americans
4 reason to fear the outcomes of jury trials; and

5 (c) Although access to jury service is more equitable than in our 6 past, concerns remain in the present day about neutral application of 7 common law or statutory law concerning the exclusion of certain 8 potential jurors from juries.

9 SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, add 24-11-115 as
10 follows:

11 24-11-115. Juror Appreciation Day. (1) THE FIFTH DAY OF 12 SEPTEMBER IN EACH YEAR, THE SAME BEING THE ANNIVERSARY OF ONE OF 13 THE MOST FAMOUS JURY VERDICTS IN UNITED STATES HISTORY, IS KNOWN AS "JURY APPRECIATION DAY". APPROPRIATE OBSERVANCE BY SUITABLE 14 15 MEANS MAY BE HELD BY THE PUBLIC, BY ALL JURY COMMISSIONERS, AND 16 IN ALL PUBLIC SCHOOLS OF THE STATE TO RECOGNIZE THE IMPORTANCE OF 17 JURY SERVICE TO THE COMMUNITY, THE IMPORTANCE OF JURY TRIALS TO 18 THE STATE, AND THE GREAT CONTRIBUTION JURY TRIALS MAKE TO THE 19 CAUSE OF FREEDOM. ALL EFFORTS AND UNDERTAKINGS IN CELEBRATING 20 JURY APPRECIATION DAY MUST BE IN HARMONY WITH THE GENERAL 21 CHARACTER OF THE DAY SO ESTABLISHED.

- (2) ANNUALLY, THE GOVERNOR SHALL ISSUE A PROCLAMATIONCALLING FOR THE RECOGNITION OF JURY APPRECIATION DAY.
- 24 (3) ON JURY APPRECIATION DAY, EACH STATE AGENCY SHALL
  25 REMAIN STAFFED AT A MINIMUM LEVEL TO CONDUCT THE USUAL
  26 OPERATIONS OF THE AGENCY.
- 27 (4) A HOLIDAY ALLOWED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION IS IN LIEU OF

A LEGAL HOLIDAY DESCRIBED IN SECTION 24-11-101 (1). THE TOTAL
 NUMBER OF LEGAL HOLIDAYS IN A STATE FISCAL YEAR AVAILABLE TO AN
 EMPLOYEE OF A STATE AGENCY IS NOT CHANGED BY THIS SECTION.

4 SECTION 3. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act 5 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the 6 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except 7 that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article 8 V of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of 9 this act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be 10 11 held in November 2024 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of 12 the official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
