Bill Topic: PRADER-WILLI SYNDROME

Summary of Fiscal Impact: **No fiscal impact.** The bill strikes language from a statutory legislative declaration regarding Prader-Willi Syndrome. The bill does not affect the revenue or expenditures of any state or local government and is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Appropriation Summary: No appropriation is required.

Fiscal Note Status: The fiscal note reflects the enacted bill.

Summary of Legislation

The bill strikes outdated language from the legislative declaration in Section 25.5-6-402, C.R.S., concerning Prader-Willi syndrome.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

The bill makes nonsubstantive changes to state statute that will not affect the operations of Medicaid or any other state program. Thus, the bill will not affect state or local revenue or expenditures and is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor and took effect on March 31, 2023.
