### **Summary of Legislation**

The bill permits the Department of Law to make rules regarding consumer legal funding (CLF) loan deferral charges. CLF is an agreement between a person with a pending legal claim and a company that offers the person cash assistance in exchange for a percentage of the settlement or award.

### **State Expenditures**

The bill will increase workload for the Department of Law in FY 2023-24 for associated rulemaking. This workload increase is assumed to minimal and not require any appropriation.

#### **Effective Date**

The bill takes effect 90 days following adjournment of the General Assembly sine die, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
