**Description of Amendments in This Packet**

**J.001** Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating \$75,167 from the Healthcare Affordability and Sustainability Fee Cash Fund to the Department of Health Care Policy and Financing for FY 2023-24. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department will require an additional 1.7 FTE and the Department will receive \$75,165 federal funds to implement the act.
