Current Appropriations Clause in Bill

The bill includes an appropriation clause that provides \$23,265 cash funds from the DRIVES Vehicle Services Account to the Department of Revenue for FY 2023-24. This amount is not consistent with the Revised Fiscal Note, which was updated to reflect new computer programming

rates in the Department of Revenue. The Revised Fiscal Note now shows a required appropriation of \$24,409 cash funds in FY 2023-24.

Description of Amendments in This Packet

J.002 Staff has prepared amendment **J.002** (attached) to change the existing clause to appropriate \$24,409 cash funds from the DRIVES Vehicle Services Account to the Department of Revenue for FY 2023-24. This represents an increase of \$1,144 relative to the existing clause.

Points to Consider

Future Fiscal Impact

Although this bill would not require a General Fund appropriation for FY 2023-24, it is projected to require General Fund appropriations of \$557,895 in FY 2024-25 and \$2,641,101 in FY 2025-26, with further increases in subsequent years.
