The Revised Fiscal Note shows a total appropriation of \$95.03 million from two cash funds, including \$69.83 million from the Colorado Water Conservation Board (CWCB) Construction Fund and \$25.2 million from the Water Plan Implementation Cash Fund. However, the bill currently includes a total appropriation of \$97.03 million, including \$63.83 million from the CWCB Construction Fund, \$25.2 million from the Water Plan Implementation Cash Fund, \$8.0 million from the Wildlife Cash Fund.
