Bill Topic: NON-TENURED TRACK FACULTY

Summary of Fiscal Impact: **No fiscal impact.** The bill extends the maximum contract length for non-tenure track teachers and librarians. It is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Appropriation Summary: No appropriation is required.

Fiscal Note Status: The fiscal note reflects the enacted bill.

Summary of Legislation

The bill extends the maximum length of employment contracts between state institutions of higher education and non-tenure track teachers or librarians from three years to five years.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

The bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact. It extends the maximum length of contracts between institutions of higher education and non-tenure track teachers and librarians, but is not expected to change the workload, revenue, or expenditures for any state or local government agencies, including institutions of higher education.

Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on March 23, 2023 and takes effect August 7, 2023, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
