### **Summary of Legislation**

Under current law, registered apprenticeship programs are required to submit certain information to the Department of Labor and Employment (CDLE) for inclusion in the Colorado State Apprenticeship Directory. The bill clarifies the information that must be submitted to CDLE and included in the directory, requires that the directory include information on program standards, and clarifies definitions for the purposes of the directory.

The bill also specifies how CDLE must promote public awareness of the directory, including providing technical assistance on how to update program information and resources to promote apprenticeship openings to the public.

### **State Expenditures**

In FY 2023-24, the bill increases workload for the Office of Future of Work in CDLE to modify the information in the directory and the public awareness approaches to align with the bill. No change in appropriations is required.

#### **Effective Date**

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on April 17, 2023 and takes effect on August 7, 2023, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
