Bill Topic: REMOVE ERRONEOUS DATE FROM CLIMBER ACT

Summary of Fiscal Impact:

No fiscal impact. The bill updates the CLIMBER Act to remove an erroneous date.

It is assessed as having no fiscal impact on state or local governments.

Appropriation Summary:

No appropriation is required.

Fiscal Note Status:

The fiscal note reflects the enacted bill, which was recommended by the Statutory

Revision Committee.

Summary of Legislation

The bill removes a reference to an erroneous date in the Colorado Loans for Increasing Main Street Business Economic Recovery Act, or CLIMBER Act.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

Updating statutory language for consistency and eliminating an erroneous date will have no impact on state or local government revenue or expenditures, and, therefore the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on May 24, 2023, and takes effect on August 7, 2023, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
