# **Summary of Legislation**

The bill expands the use of the Small Communities Water and Wastewater Grant Fund by the Department of Public Health and Environment to include a state match as required by the federal Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act.

### **State Expenditures**

This expanded use of the Small Communities Water and Wastewater Grant Fund, which is continuously appropriated to CDPHE, will allow the department to access federal funds with a 10 percent state match. This is estimated to require \$6 million to secure \$60 million in federal funds. The fiscal note shows expenditures taking place in FY 2023-24; the timing of actual expenditures will depend on the availability of federal funds and on implementation decisions by CDPHE.

#### **Local Government**

To the extent that additional federal funds received are used for local government infrastructure projects, local revenue and expenditures will increase correspondingly.

#### **Effective Date**

The bill takes effect upon signature of the Governor, or upon becoming law without his signature.
