SB 23-243

Summary of Legislation

The bill transfers \$294.2 million for capital construction and information technology projects in FY 2023-24.

State Transfers

On July 1, 2023, the bill transfers:

- \$233,361,030 from the General Fund to the Capital Construction Fund;
- \$60,308,481 from the General Fund to the IT Capital Account of the Capital Construction Fund; and
- \$500,000 from the General Fund Exempt Account to the Capital Construction Fund.

Effective Date

This bill was signed into law by the Governor and took effect on April 20, 2023.
