Budget package bill. The bill updates and clarifies accessibility standards for state information technology systems. It minimally increases state workload in FY 2023-24.

Appropriation Summary: No appropriation is required.

Fiscal Note Status: The fiscal note reflects the enacted bill.

Summary of Legislation

The bill requires the Office of Information Technology to adopt rules regarding accessibility standards for IT systems employed by state agencies; clarifies that a claim brought for a violation of accessibility standards constitutes a single claim for each digital product; and repeals obsolete provisions. The bill also extends agencies' spending authority made in FY 2023-24 for IT accessibility through FY 2025-26.

State Expenditures

The bill increases workload in the Office of Information Technology to conduct rulemaking, with support from the Department of Law, in FY 2023-24. This can be accomplished within existing appropriations.

Effective Date

This bill was signed into law by the Governor and took effect on April 20, 2023.
