Summary of Legislation

The bill requires the State Treasurer to increase the July 1, 2023 transfer from the General Fund to the Capital Construction fund by a total of \$18,212,764. This increased transfer amends the transfer created in <u>Senate Bill 23-243</u>. This funding will support capital construction and information technology projects.

State Transfers

On July 1, 2023, the bill increases existing transfers from the General Fund by:

- \$14,607,257 to the Capital Construction Fund
- \$3,605,507 to the IT Capital Account of the Capital Construction Fund.

Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor and took effect on June 6, 2023.
