AN ACT

CONCERNING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION TO THE JUDICIAL DEPARTMENT.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. Appropriation to the judicial department for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022. In Session Laws of Colorado 2022, section 2 of chapter 507, (HB 22-1329), amend Part IX and the affected totals, as Part IX (2)(B), (5), (6), (7), (8), (9), (10), (11), and the affected totals are amended by section 11 of chapter 170, (HB 22-1133), as follows:
