# A BILL FOR AN ACT CONCERNING AUTHORIZATION FOR CERTAIN PERSONS LICENSED TO SELL ALCOHOL BEVERAGES AT RETAIL TO SELL ALCOHOL BEVERAGES FOR CONSUMPTION OFF THE LICENSED PREMISES.

## **Bill Summary**

Current law authorizes certain businesses licensed to sell alcohol beverages at retail by the drink to deliver these beverages or to allow the customer to take these beverages from the licensed premises. This authorization is scheduled to repeal on July 1, 2025. The bill removes this repeal, thereby continuing indefinitely the authorization for alcohol

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 1 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 44-3-911, repeal (7) 3 as follows: 4 44-3-911. Takeout and delivery of alcohol beverages - permit 5 - on-premises consumption licenses - requirements and limitations -6 rules - definition. (7) This section is repealed, effective July 1, 2025. 7 **SECTION 2.** Act subject to petition - effective date. This act 8 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the 9 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except 10 that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V 11 of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this 12 act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take 13 effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in 14 November 2024 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the 15 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
