A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING STANDARDS FOR FACILITIES THAT USE TEST SUBJECTS IN
102 HEALTH-RELATED RESEARCH.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. The bill requires a facility that uses animals for health-related research to:

- Submit annual reports to the department of public health and environment regarding the use of animals in the facility; and
- Transfer dogs and cats owned by the facility to animal

shelters and pet animal rescues before euthanizing the animal.

14	that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V
15	of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this
16	act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take
17	effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
18	November 2024 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
19	official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
