Water Resources and Agriculture Review Committee. The bill extends to December 31, 2025, the time in which the department of agriculture may implement wild horse population management pursuant to Senate Bill 23-275.

4 35-1-119. Wild horse population management - repeal. 5 (2) This section is repealed, effective July 31, 2024 DECEMBER 31, 2025. 6 SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly finds, 7 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate 8 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety or for appropriations for 9 the support and maintenance of the departments of the state and state 10 institutions.
