Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 35-1-119, **amend** (2) as follows:

35-1-119. Wild horse population management - repeal. (2) This section is repealed, effective July 31, 2024 DECEMBER 31, 2025.
