A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING LOCAL GOVERNMENT AUTHORITY OVER THE

102 **REGULATION OF BURNING IN BURN BARRELS.**

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. If this bill passes third reading in the house of introduction, a bill summary that applies to the reengrossed version of this bill will be available at <u>http://leg.colorado.gov.</u>)

The bill clarifies that local governments, rather than the air quality control commission or the department of public health and environment, control the regulation of burning in burn barrels. Burning in burn barrels is permitted as regulated by or unless prohibited by the local government.

Dashes through the words or numbers indicate deletions from existing law. 1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

2 SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25-7-109, add (8)(c)
3 as follows:

4 25-7-109. Commission to promulgate emission control 5 **regulations - definition.** (8) (c) NOTWITHSTANDING SUBSECTION (2)(c) 6 OF THIS SECTION OR ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS SECTION, BURNING IN 7 BURN BARRELS IS NOT OPEN BURNING, AND THE COMMISSION SHALL NOT 8 REGULATE BURNING IN BURN BARRELS, WHICH IS PERMITTED, UNLESS 9 PROHIBITED BY A LOCAL GOVERNMENT, AS REGULATED BY A LOCAL 10 GOVERNMENT PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 25-7-128, 30-15-401, AND 11 30-20-110. AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "LOCAL GOVERNMENT" MEANS A 12 HOME RULE OR STATUTORY COUNTY, CITY AND COUNTY, OR 13 MUNICIPALITY.

SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25-7-123, add
(1)(b.5) as follows:

16 **Open burning - penalties - definition.** 25-7-123. 17 (1) (b.5) BURNING IN BURN BARRELS IS NOT OPEN BURNING, IS PERMITTED 18 UNLESS PROHIBITED BY A LOCAL GOVERNMENT, AND MAY BE REGULATED 19 ONLY BY A LOCAL GOVERNMENT PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 25-7-128, 20 30-15-401, AND 30-20-110. BURNING IN BURN BARRELS DOES NOT 21 CONSTITUTE OPERATION OF AN INCINERATOR. AS USED IN THIS SECTION, 22 "LOCAL GOVERNMENT" MEANS A HOME RULE OR STATUTORY COUNTY, 23 CITY AND COUNTY, OR MUNICIPALITY.

SECTION 3. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25-7-128, amend (1)
as follows:

26 25-7-128. Local government - authority - penalty.
27 (1) (a) Home rule cities, cities, towns, counties, and cities and counties

are hereby authorized to enact local air pollution resolutions or ordinances. Every such resolution or ordinance shall MUST provide for hearings, judicial review, and injunctions consistent with sections 25-7-118 to 25-7-121 and shall include emission control regulations which are at least the same as, or may be more restrictive than, the emission control regulations adopted pursuant to this article; except that:

(I) Nothing in this article shall prohibit ARTICLE 7 PROHIBITS any
such local law from controlling any air pollution or air pollution source
which is not subject to control under the provisions of this article; and
except that

11 (II) No permit issued under any local air pollution law with 12 respect to any facility, activity, or process shall ever be construed to 13 relieve RELIEVES any holder thereof from the duty to maintain such 14 facility, activity, or process in compliance with the emission standards 15 and emission control regulations adopted pursuant to this article nor to 16 relieve OR RELIEVES the division from its duty to enforce such emission 17 standards and emission control regulations with respect to such facility, 18 activity, or process; AND

(III) LOCAL GOVERNMENT REGULATIONS, RATHER THAN THOSE
ADOPTED PURSUANT TO THIS ARTICLE 7 BY THE COMMISSION OR THE
DIVISION, CONTROL BURNING IN BURN BARRELS. UNLESS PROHIBITED BY
A LOCAL GOVERNMENT, BURNING IN BURN BARRELS IS PERMITTED AS
REGULATED BY A LOCAL GOVERNMENT PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION AND
SECTIONS 30-15-401 AND 30-20-110.

(b) Any local air pollution standards or regulations submitted and
approved as revisions to the state implementation plan shall be enforced
as such by the division. In order to assure coordination of efforts to

control and abate air pollution, local governmental entities are encouraged
 to submit their adopted plans and regulations as revisions to the state
 implementation plan for Colorado.

4 SECTION 4. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 30-15-401, add
5 (1)(n.5)(II.5) as follows:

30-15-401. General regulations - definitions. (1) In addition to
those powers granted by sections 30-11-101 and 30-11-107 and by parts
1, 2, and 3 of this article 15, the board of county commissioners may
adopt ordinances for control or licensing of those matters of purely local
concern that are described in the following enumerated powers:

11 (n.5) (II.5) TO ALLOW FOR AND REGULATE BURNING IN BURN
12 BARRELS.

13 SECTION 5. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 30-20-110, amend
14 (3) as follows:

30-20-110. Minimum standards. (3) As used in subsection (2)
of this section, "noncommercial burning of trash" includes the burning of
wood waste in wigwam wood waste burners AND BURNING IN BURN
BARRELS.

19 SECTION 6. Safety clause. The general assembly finds, 20 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate 21 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety or for appropriations for 22 the support and maintenance of the departments of the state and state 23 institutions.
