Bill Summary

In 2016, the general assembly enacted HB 16-1284, which requires the public employees' retirement association (PERA) to periodically identify all companies that have economic prohibitions against Israel and to divest all direct holdings of those companies from its assets and prohibits PERA from acquiring new direct holdings in any of those companies. The bill repeals the statutory provisions enacted in HB 16-1284.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 1 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **repeal** part 2 of 3 article 54.8 of title 24. 4 **SECTION 2.** Act subject to petition - effective date. This act 5 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the 6 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except 7 that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V 8 of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this 9 act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take 10 effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in 11 November 2024 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the 12 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
