A BILL FOR AN ACT

CONCERNING THE CONTINUATION OF THE SENIOR DENTAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE.

Bill Summary

Sunset Process - House Health and Human Services Committee. The senior dental advisory committee created in the department of health care policy and financing is scheduled to repeal on September 1, 2024. Pursuant to the recommendation in the department of regulatory agencies' sunset review and report, the bill continues the senior dental advisory committee indefinitely.

4	2-3-1203. Sunset review of advisory committees - legislative
5	declaration - definition - repeal. (15) (a) The following statutory
6	authorizations for the designated advisory committees are scheduled for
7	repeal on September 1, 2024:
8	(IV) The senior dental advisory committee created in section
9	25.5-3-406, C.R.S.;
10	SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25.5-3-406, repeal
11	(3) as follows:
12	25.5-3-406. Senior dental advisory committee - creation -
13	duties. (3) (a) This section is repealed, effective September 1, 2024.
14	(b) Prior to said repeal, the advisory committee must be reviewed
15	as provided for in section 2-3-1203, C.R.S.
16	SECTION 3. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act
17	takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
18	ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except
19	that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V
20	of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this
21	act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take
22	effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
23	November 2024 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
24	official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
