A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING VOLUNTARY PAYROLL DEDUCTIONS FOR STATE 102 EMPLOYEES.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. Current law allows employees in the state personnel system and state employees that are covered under the "State Employee Group Benefits Act" to participate in a group benefit plan that includes any group benefit coverages contracted for or administered by the state personnel director (director).Such group benefit coverages include but are not limited to medical, dental, life, and disability benefits.

The bill expands the definition of group benefit plans to include voluntary and flexible benefits. The bill also defines voluntary benefit to mean a variety of benefit plans contracted for or administered by the director for which an employee may select voluntary payroll deductions that may be matched by a state contribution.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:* 2 SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-50-603, amend 3 (9); and **add** (14) as follows: 4 **24-50-603.** Definitions. As used in this part 6, unless the context 5 otherwise requires: 6 (9) "Group benefit plans" means any group benefit coverages 7 BENEFITS contracted for or administered by the director, including but not 8 limited to, medical, dental, life, and disability benefits. GROUP BENEFIT 9 PLANS MAY ALSO INCLUDE VOLUNTARY BENEFITS AND FLEXIBLE BENEFITS 10 AS DETERMINED BY THE DIRECTOR. For purposes of section 24-50-104 11 (1)(a)(I), "group benefit plans" includes any group benefit coverages 12 BENEFITS offered by a state institution of higher education to employees 13 of such institution who are in the state personnel system. 14 (14) "VOLUNTARY BENEFITS" MEANS A VARIETY OF BENEFIT PLANS 15 CONTRACTED FOR OR ADMINISTERED BY THE DIRECTOR THAT AN 16 EMPLOYEE CAN SELECT BY CONTRIBUTING A PREDETERMINED PORTION OF 17

18 AVAILABLE, THE EMPLOYEE'S CONTRIBUTION MAY BE MATCHED BY A 19 STATE CONTRIBUTION.

THE EMPLOYEE'S SALARY TO PAY FOR SUCH BENEFITS AND FOR WHICH, IF

20 SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act 21 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the 22 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except 23 that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V

of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this
act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take
effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
November 2024 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
