The bill continues the executive director's rule-making authority for 7 years, until September 1, 2031.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-34-104, **repeal**
3 (25)(a)(XXII); and **add** (32)(a)(XI) as follows:

4 **24-34-104. General assembly review of regulatory agencies**
5 **and functions for repeal, continuation, or reestablishment - legislative**
6 **declaration - repeal.** (25) (a) The following agencies, functions, or both,
7 are scheduled for repeal on September 1, 2024:

10 (32) (a) The following agencies, functions, or both, are scheduled

15 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 26.5-1-105, **amend**
16 (1)(c) as follows:

17 **26.5-1-105. Powers and duties of the executive director - rules**
18 **- rules advisory council - repeal.** (1) (c) This subsection (1) is repealed,
19 effective ~~September 1, 2024~~ SEPTEMBER 1, 2031. Before the repeal, this
20 subsection (1) is scheduled for review in accordance with section
21 24-34-104.

22 **SECTION 3. Act subject to petition - effective date.** This act
23 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the

1 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except
2 that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V
3 of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this
4 act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take
5 effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
6 November 2024 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
7 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
