## **Bill Summary**

**Joint Budget Committee.** The bill requires the state treasurer to transfer \$10 million from the energy and carbon management cash fund to the stationary sources control fund on June 30, 2024.

HOUSE 2nd Reading Unamended March 28, 2024 1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

2 SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 34-60-122, add
3 (5)(e) as follows:

34-60-122. Expenses - energy and carbon management cash
fund created. (5) (e) ON JUNE 30, 2024, THE STATE TREASURER SHALL
TRANSFER TEN MILLION DOLLARS FROM THE ENERGY AND CARBON
MANAGEMENT CASH FUND TO THE STATIONARY SOURCES CONTROL FUND
CREATED IN SECTION 25-7-114.7 (2)(b)(I).

9 SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25-7-114.7, add
10 (2)(b)(V) as follows:

11 25-7-114.7. Emission fees - fund - rules - definition.
12 (2) (b) (V) IN ADDITION TO THE MONEY CREDITED OR TRANSFERRED TO
13 THE STATIONARY SOURCES CONTROL FUND, THE FUND CONSISTS OF THE
14 MONEY TRANSFERRED TO THE FUND FROM THE ENERGY AND CARBON
15 MANAGEMENT CASH FUND PURSUANT TO SECTION 34-60-122 (5)(e).

16 SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly finds, 17 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate 18 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety or for appropriations for 19 the support and maintenance of the departments of the state and state 20 institutions.
