### A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING THE COST THRESHOLD OF CONTROLLED MAINTENANCE
102 PROJECTS FOR CAPITAL RENEWAL.

## **Bill Summary**

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. **Joint Budget Committee.** The bill increases the cost threshold above which a controlled maintenance project of real property is deemed to be "capital renewal" (cost threshold). The cost threshold is increased from \$2 million to \$5 million. The bill also requires the department of personnel to adjust the cost threshold for inflation every 3 years beginning on January 1, 2029, and to publish the cost threshold on its website.

7	of real property or more than one integrated controlled maintenance

9	dollars in a fiscal year and that is more cost effective or better addressed
10	by corrective repairs or replacement to the real property rather than by
11	limited fixed equipment repair, replacement, or smaller individual
12	controlled maintenance projects.
13	(b) Beginning on January 1, 2029, and on January 1 of
14	EVERY THREE-YEAR PERIOD THEREAFTER, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL
15	ADJUST THE CAPITAL RENEWAL COST THRESHOLD FOR INFLATION IN
16	ACCORDANCE WITH THE PERCENTAGE CHANGE OVER THE PRECEDING
17	THREE-YEAR PERIOD IN THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF LABOR
18	BUREAU OF LABOR STATISTICS PRODUCER PRICE INDEX FOR THE BUILDING
19	MATERIALS AND SUPPLIES DEALERS INDUSTRY, OR ITS SUCCESSOR INDEX.
20	THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PUBLISH THE ADJUSTED CAPITAL RENEWAL COST
21	THRESHOLD ON ITS WEBSITE.
22	SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date -
23	applicability. (1) This act takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following
24	the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the
25	general assembly; except that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant
26	to section 1 (3) of article V of the state constitution against this act or an

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- item, section, or part of this act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in November 2024 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
- 6 (2) This act applies to controlled maintenance projects of real 7 property commencing on or after the applicable effective date of this act.

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
