Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. The bill gives the Colorado state patrol authority to provide law enforcement services for the Ralph L. Carr Colorado judicial center and its grounds and provide protection for Colorado judges and justices when they are present in the state capitol buildings group.

Dashes through the words or numbers indicate deletions from existing law. 1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

2 SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, add 13-1-141 as
3 follows:

4 13-1-141. Ralph L. Carr Colorado judicial center - Colorado
5 state patrol - law enforcement services. THE COLORADO STATE PATROL
6 SHALL PROVIDE LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES FOR THE RALPH L. CARR
7 COLORADO JUDICIAL CENTER AND ITS GROUNDS.

8 SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, amend 16-2.5-152
9 as follows:

10 **16-2.5-152.** Administrators of judicial security. An 11 administrator ADMINISTRATORS of judicial security employed by the 12 judicial department is a ARE peace officer OFFICERS whose authority 13 includes the enforcement of all laws of the state of Colorado, and such 14 administrator THE ADMINISTRATORS of judicial security must be certified 15 by the P.O.S.T. board.

SECTION 3. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-33.5-216.5,
amend (1) as follows:

18 24-33.5-216.5. Patrol services furnished to the general 19 assembly - judges and justices - definition. (1) (a) The Colorado state 20 patrol shall provide protection for the members of the general assembly 21 when they are present in the state capitol buildings group and shall 22 respond to all complaints relating to criminal activity against or security 23 threats or risks to a member of the general assembly. As used in this 24 subsection (1), "state capitol buildings group" has the same meaning as 25 set forth in section 24-82-105(1)(a).

26 (b) THE COLORADO STATE PATROL SHALL PROVIDE PROTECTION TO

2 SECTION 4. Safety clause. The general assembly finds, 3 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate 4 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety or for appropriations for 5 the support and maintenance of the departments of the state and state 6 institutions.
