101 **CONCERNING MEASURES TO SUPPORT THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE**  
102 **STATE'S REGULATED NATURAL MEDICINE PROGRAM.**

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**Bill Summary**

The bill:

- Authorizes the director of the division of professions and occupations in the department of regulatory agencies to approve facilitator education and training programs;
- Exempts facilitator education and training programs from regulation as private educational schools;

- Updates rule-making by the department of public health and environment and the state licensing authority related to laboratory testing and certification of natural medicine products;
- Prohibits individuals, rather than all persons, from having a financial interest in more than 5 natural medicine business licenses;
- Clarifies that a person may operate a natural medicine testing facility at the same location as a regulated marijuana testing facility; and
- Specifies which transfers and distributions of regulated natural medicine and regulated natural medicine products are authorized between persons licensed as healing centers, facilitators, natural medicine cultivation facilities, and natural medicine manufacturers.

2           **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 10-16-162, **amend**  
 3 (4)(b)(I)(E) as follows:

4           **10-16-162. Prohibition on discrimination for coverage based**  
 5 **solely on natural medicine consumption - definitions.** (4) As used in  
 6 this section, unless the context otherwise requires:

7           (b) (I) "Natural medicine" means the following substances:

8           (E) ~~Psilocyn~~ PSILOCIN.

9           **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-170-104, **amend**  
 10 (8) and (12)(a)(II) as follows:

11           **12-170-104. Definitions.** As used in this article 170, unless the  
 12 context otherwise requires:

13           (8) "Healing center" means a facility ~~where an entity is licensed~~  
 14 by the state licensing authority pursuant to article 50 of title 44 that  
 15 permits a facilitator to provide and supervise natural medicine services for  
 16 a participant.

17           (12) (a) "Natural medicine" means the following substances:

2 **SECTION 3.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-170-105, **amend**

11 (II) Requirements for the licensing of facilitators, practice of  
12 facilitation, and professional conduct of facilitators, including:

13 (L) THE APPROVAL OF EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS IN THE STATE  
14 INTENDED TO PREPARE INDIVIDUALS FOR LICENSURE UNDER THIS ARTICLE  
15 170, INCLUDING APPROVING CURRICULA, CONDUCTING SURVEYS, AND  
16 ESTABLISHING STANDARDS FOR THE EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS; DENIAL OF,  
17 APPROVAL OF, AND WITHDRAWAL OF APPROVAL FROM AN EDUCATIONAL  
18 PROGRAM FOR FAILURE TO MEET REQUIRED STANDARDS ESTABLISHED BY  
19 THIS ARTICLE 170 OR RULES ADOPTED BY THE DIRECTOR; ESTABLISHMENT  
20 OF STANDARDS TO DETERMINE WHETHER INSTITUTIONS OUTSIDE THIS

16 (5) (a) THE DIRECTOR MAY APPROVE A FACILITATOR EDUCATION  
17 AND TRAINING PROGRAM AND ADOPT RULES PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION  
18 (1)(a) OF THIS SECTION.

19 (b) A PERSON SEEKING APPROVAL OF AN EDUCATION AND  
20 TRAINING PROGRAM TO PREPARE INDIVIDUALS FOR LICENSURE AS A  
21 FACILITATOR SHALL APPLY TO THE DIRECTOR AND SUBMIT EVIDENCE THAT  
22 THE PROPOSED EDUCATION AND TRAINING PROGRAM COMPLIES WITH THIS  
23 ARTICLE 170 AND RULES ADOPTED BY THE DIRECTOR PURSUANT TO  
24 SUBSECTION (1)(a) OF THIS SECTION.

2 AND DEMONSTRABLE SKILLS FOR EACH INDIVIDUAL COMPLETING THE  
3 PROGRAM AND ANY ADDITIONAL CONTENT REQUIRED PURSUANT TO RULES  
4 ADOPTED BY THE DIRECTOR PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (1)(a) OF THIS  
5 SECTION.

6 (6) THE DIRECTOR OR THE DIRECTOR'S DESIGNEE MAY INSPECT AND  
7 SURVEY EACH APPROVED FACILITATOR EDUCATION AND TRAINING  
8 PROGRAM AT THE DIRECTOR'S DISCRETION.

9 (7) (a) THE DIVISION SHALL CREATE A PROCESS TO REVIEW THE  
10 DIRECTOR'S DENIAL OF AN EDUCATION AND TRAINING PROGRAM. THE  
11 PROCESS ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO THIS SUBSECTION (7) MUST REQUIRE  
12 THE DIRECTOR OR THE DIRECTOR'S DESIGNEE, DIVISION COUNSEL, AND THE  
13 CHAIR OF THE NATURAL MEDICINE ADVISORY BOARD OR THE CHAIR'S  
14 DESIGNEE TO REVIEW APPLICATIONS PRIOR TO A DENIAL BEING ISSUED BY  
15 THE DIRECTOR.

16 (b) IF THE APPLICANT IS DENIED APPROVAL AFTER THE REVIEW  
17 PROCESS CREATED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (7)(a) OF THIS SECTION, THE  
18 DIRECTOR SHALL DOCUMENT THE GROUNDS FOR DENIAL AND SUBMIT THAT  
19 DOCUMENTATION TO THE APPLICANT.

20 (8) THE DIVISION SHALL REGULARLY REVIEW THE NATURAL  
21 MEDICINE PROGRAM, INCLUDING THE APPROVAL PROCESS FOR  
22 FACILITATOR EDUCATION AND TRAINING PROGRAMS. THE DIVISION SHALL  
23 INCLUDE THE REVIEW IN THE ANNUAL REPORTING REQUIRED IN  
24 SUBSECTION (1)(j) OF THIS SECTION.

25 **SECTION 4.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 18-18-434, **amend**  
26 (12)(b)(I)(E) as follows:

27 **18-18-434. Offenses relating to natural medicine and natural**

1 **medicine product - definitions.** (12) As used in this section, unless the  
2 context otherwise requires:

3 (b) (I) "Natural medicine" means the following substances:

4 (E) ~~Psilocyn~~ PSILOCIN.

5 **SECTION 5.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 23-64-104, **amend**  
6 (1)(p) and (1)(q); and **add** (1)(r) as follows:

7 **23-64-104. Exemptions.** (1) The following educational  
8 institutions and educational services are exempt from this article 64:

9 (p) Yoga teacher training courses, programs, and schools; ~~and~~

10 (q) Training of guides, trip leaders, and guide instructors by river  
11 outfitters licensed pursuant to section 33-32-104; AND

12 (r) EDUCATION AND TRAINING PROGRAMS APPROVED BY THE  
13 DIRECTOR OF THE DIVISION OF PROFESSIONS AND OCCUPATIONS IN THE  
14 DEPARTMENT OF REGULATORY AGENCIES UNDER ARTICLE 170 OF TITLE 12.

15 **SECTION 6.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25-1.5-120, **amend**  
16 (1), (2)(a), (2)(b), and (2)(c) as follows:

17 **25-1.5-120. Natural medicine testing and standards - rules.**

18 (1) The department of public health and environment, in coordination  
19 with the department of revenue, to ensure consistency between rules, shall  
20 promulgate rules concerning testing standards and LABORATORY  
21 certification requirements of natural medicine and natural medicine  
22 product regulated by the department of revenue pursuant to article 50 of  
23 title 44.

24 (2) At a minimum, the rules must:

25 (a) Establish natural medicine and natural medicine product  
26 LABORATORY testing standards and ~~certification~~ requirements;

27 (b) Establish a natural medicine independent LABORATORY testing

1 and certification program for licensees pursuant to article 50 of title 44,  
2 within an implementation time frame established by the department of  
3 revenue, requiring licensees to test natural medicine and natural medicine  
4 product to ensure, at a minimum, that products transferred for human  
5 consumption by ~~natural persons or entities~~ licensed pursuant to article 50  
6 of title 44 do not contain contaminants that are injurious to health and to  
7 ensure correct labeling;

8 (c) Establish procedures that ~~ensure natural medicine and natural~~  
9 ~~medicine product are quarantined and~~ REQUIRE notification procedures TO  
10 THE STATE LICENSING AUTHORITY if test results indicate the presence of  
11 quantities of any substance determined to be injurious to health;

12 **SECTION 7.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25-56-104.5, **add** (6)  
13 as follows:

14 **25-56-104.5. Prohibition on discrimination for organ**  
15 **transplants based solely on natural medicine consumption -**  
16 **applicability - definitions.** (6) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:

17 (a) "NATURAL MEDICINE" HAS THE SAME MEANING AS SET FORTH  
18 IN SECTION 44-50-103 (13).

19 (b) "NATURAL MEDICINE PRODUCT" HAS THE SAME MEANING AS  
20 SET FORTH IN SECTION 44-50-103 (15).

21 **SECTION 8.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 44-50-103, **amend**  
22 (3), (4), (5), (6), and (13)(a)(II) as follows:

23 **44-50-103. Definitions.** As used in this article 50, unless the  
24 context otherwise requires:

25 (3) "Director" means the director of the NATURAL MEDICINE  
26 division of ~~professions and occupations~~ or the director's designee.

27 (4) "Division" means the NATURAL MEDICINE division of

1 professions and occupations created in the department. pursuant to section  
2 12-20-103.

3 (5) "Facilitator" means a natural person who is twenty-one years  
4 of age or older, has the necessary qualifications, training, experience, and  
5 knowledge to perform and supervise natural medicine services for a  
6 participant, and is licensed TO ENGAGE IN THE PRACTICE OF FACILITATION  
7 by the director to engage in the practice of facilitation OF THE DIVISION OF  
8 PROFESSIONS AND OCCUPATIONS IN THE DEPARTMENT OF REGULATORY  
9 AGENCIES PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 170 OF TITLE 12.

10 (6) "Healing center" means a facility where an entity is licensed  
11 by the state licensing authority PURSUANT TO THIS ARTICLE 50 that permits  
12 a facilitator to provide and supervise natural medicine services for a  
13 participant.

14 (13) (a) "Natural medicine" means the following substances:

15 (II) Psilocyn PSILOCIN.

16 **SECTION 9.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 44-50-203, **amend**  
17 (1)(e), (1)(f)(I)(B), and (2)(p) as follows:

18 **44-50-203. State licensing authority - rules. (1) Mandatory**  
19 **rule-making.** Rules promulgated pursuant to section 44-50-202 (1)(b)  
20 must include the following subjects:

21 (e) Permissible and prohibited financial interests in a license  
22 issued pursuant to this article 50 or a license issued pursuant to article 170  
23 of title 12; except that a person may AN INDIVIDUAL SHALL not have a  
24 financial interest in more than five natural medicine business licenses;

25 (f) (I) Establishment of a natural medicine independent testing and  
26 certification program for licensees within an implementation time frame  
27 established by the division, requiring licensees to test regulated natural



1 medicine and regulated natural medicine product to ensure, at a  
2 minimum, that regulated natural medicine and regulated natural medicine  
3 product transferred for human consumption by persons licensed pursuant  
4 to this article 50 do not contain contaminants that are injurious to health  
5 and to ensure correct labeling, as well as:

6 (B) Testing ~~procedures and frequency of~~ REQUIREMENTS FOR  
7 regulated natural medicine and regulated natural medicine product by  
8 licensees;

9 (2) Permissive rule-making. Rules promulgated pursuant to  
10 section 44-50-202 (1)(b) may include, but need not be limited to, the  
11 following subjects:

12 (p) Requirements for inspections, investigations, searches,  
13 seizures, forfeitures, embargoes, quarantines, recalls, DESTRUCTION, and  
14 such additional activities as may become necessary;

15 **SECTION 10.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 44-50-301, **amend**  
16 (4) as follows:

17 **44-50-301. Classes of licenses.** (4) (a) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN  
18 SUBSECTION (4)(b) OF THIS SECTION, a person ~~may~~ SHALL not operate a  
19 license issued pursuant to this article 50 at the same location as a license  
20 or permit issued pursuant to article 3, 4, 5, or 10 of this title 44.

21 (b) A PERSON MAY OPERATE A NATURAL MEDICINE TESTING  
22 FACILITY LICENSE ISSUED PURSUANT TO SECTION 44-50-404 AT THE SAME  
23 LOCATION AS A REGULATED MARIJUANA TESTING FACILITY LICENSE ISSUED  
24 PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 10 OF THIS TITLE 44.

25 **SECTION 11.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 44-50-401, **amend**  
26 (2) as follows:

27 **44-50-401. Natural medicine healing center license - rules.**

1 (2) A natural medicine healing center licensee may transfer regulated  
2 natural medicine or regulated natural medicine product to another natural  
3 medicine healing center licensee OR A FACILITATOR pursuant to rules  
4 promulgated by the state licensing authority.

5 **SECTION 12.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 44-50-402, **amend**  
6 (1) as follows:

7 **44-50-402. Natural medicine cultivation facility license.** (1) A  
8 natural medicine cultivation facility license may be issued PURSUANT TO  
9 STATE LICENSING AUTHORITY RULES AND only to a person who cultivates  
10 regulated natural medicine for transfer and distribution to natural  
11 medicine healing center licensees, natural medicine product manufacturer  
12 licensees, ~~or~~ other natural medicine cultivation facility licensees, OR  
13 OTHER PERSONS LICENSED UNDER ARTICLE 170 OF TITLE 12 OR THIS  
14 ARTICLE 50.

15 **SECTION 13.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 44-50-403, **add** (3)  
16 as follows:

17 **44-50-403. Natural medicine product manufacturer license.**  
18 (3) PURSUANT TO RULES PROMULGATED BY THE STATE LICENSING  
19 AUTHORITY, A NATURAL MEDICINE PRODUCT MANUFACTURER LICENSEE  
20 MAY TRANSFER AND DISTRIBUTE REGULATED NATURAL MEDICINE AND A  
21 REGULATED NATURAL MEDICINE PRODUCT TO ANOTHER PERSON LICENSED  
22 UNDER ARTICLE 170 OF TITLE 12 OR ANOTHER PERSON LICENSED UNDER  
23 THIS ARTICLE 50.

24 **SECTION 14. Safety clause.** The general assembly finds,  
25 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate  
26 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety or for appropriations for

- 1 the support and maintenance of the departments of the state and state
- 2 institutions.
