SUBMITTING TO THE REGISTERED ELECTORS OF THE STATE OF

COLORADO AN AMENDMENT TO THE COLORADO CONSTITUTION

CONCERNING A PROHIBITION ON A PERSON BEING A STATE

LEGISLATOR FOR A TERM OF OFFICE IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING

A TERM FOR WHICH THE PERSON WAS APPOINTED TO FILL A

VACANCY IN THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY FOR THAT OFFICE.

Resolution Summary

If approved by a vote of at least 55% of the voters of the state

voting on the issue at the 2024 general election, the concurrent resolution prohibits a person from being a state representative or senator for a term of office that immediately follows a term for which the person was appointed to fill a vacancy in the general assembly for that office.

1 Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the 2 Seventy-fourth General Assembly of the State of Colorado, the Senate 3 concurring herein: 4 **SECTION 1.** At the election held on November 5, 2024, the 5 secretary of state shall submit to the registered electors of the state the 6 ballot title set forth in section 2 for the following amendment to the state 7 constitution: 8 In the constitution of the state of Colorado, amend section 4 of article V as follows: 9 10 **Section 4. Qualifications of members.** (1) No person shall be a 11 representative or senator who shall HAS not have attained the age of 12 twenty-five years, who shall IS not be a citizen of the United States, and 13 who shall HAS not for at least twelve months next preceding his THE 14 PERSON'S election, have resided within the territory included in the limits 15 of the district in which he THE PERSON shall be chosen. 16 (2) IN ADDITION TO THE REQUIREMENTS SET FORTH IN SUBSECTION 17 (1) OF THIS SECTION, NO PERSON SHALL BE A REPRESENTATIVE OR 18 SENATOR FOR A TERM OF OFFICE THAT IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWS A TERM 19 FOR WHICH THE PERSON WAS APPOINTED TO FILL A VACANCY IN THE 20 GENERAL ASSEMBLY FOR THAT OFFICE. 21 **SECTION 2.** Each elector voting at the election may cast a vote 22 either "Yes/For" or "No/Against" on the following ballot title: "Shall 23 there be an amendment to the Colorado constitution concerning a

prohibition on a person being a state legislator for a term of office immediately following a term for which the person was appointed to fill a vacancy in the general assembly for that office?"

SECTION 3. Except as otherwise provided in section 1-40-123, Colorado Revised Statutes, if at least fifty-five percent of the electors voting on the ballot title vote "Yes/For", then the amendment will become part of the state constitution.
