*Future Fiscal Impact*

This bill does not require a cash fund appropriation for FY 2024-25. However, it is projected to require a cash fund appropriation of approximately \$306,120 from the Colorado DRIVES Vehicle Services Account in FY 2025-26 and \$162,761 from the Colorado DRIVES Vehicle Services Account and 2.1 FTE in FY 2026-27.
