*Future Fiscal Impact*

While the bill does not require an appropriation for FY 2024-25, it is estimated to require cash fund appropriations of \$9,620 in FY 2025-26 and \$16,803 in FY 2026-27. The bill is also estimated to increase cash fund revenues by \$32,470 in FY 2026-27.
