## **Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

The bill includes an appropriation clause that provides an appropriation of \$2,000,000 from the State Education Fund for the Ninth-grade Success Program and *eliminates* the existing General Fund appropriation of \$792,444 for the program that is in the FY 2024-25 Long Bill. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department will require a net increase of 0.8 FTE.

#### **Points to Consider**

### General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee has proposed a budget package for FY 2024-25 based on the March 2024 Office of State Planning and Budgeting (OSPB) revenue forecast. The budget package includes \$63.1 million in set-asides for legislation outside of the package (see table below). The budget package accounts for the 15.0 percent reserve associated with the placeholders (a total of \$9.5 million).

This bill *reduces* General Fund appropriations by \$792,444, increasing General Fund available for other legislation by the same amount.
