Bill Topic:	LABOR UNION FOR SCHOOL EMPLOYEES DUE RESTRICTION		
Summary of Fiscal Impact:	No fiscal impact. The bill prohibits a teachers' union from using membership dues to promote the election of officials or ballot measures.		
Appropriation Summary:	No appropriation is required.		
Fiscal Note Status:	The final fiscal note reflects the introduced bill. The bill was postponed indefinitely by the House Education Committee on March 21, 2024; therefore, the impacts identified in this analysis do not take effect.		

Summary of Legislation

The bill prohibits an educators' union from directly using an employee's labor union membership dues to promote the election or reelection of a public officer or to promote a local or state ballot measure to which the employee has expressed opposition.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

The bill primarily impacts the relationship between teachers' unions and members, and does not impact the revenue, expenditures, or workload of any state or local agency. For this reason, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect 90 days following adjournment of the General Assembly sine die, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
