	The bill modifies disclosure requirements for insurance carriers. The bill minimally increases state workload in FY 2024-25 only.

Summary of Legislation

The bill repeals an unfair competition statute that placed disclosure requirements on automobile, homeowners, and renters insurance policies and recreates the requirements for automobile policies under the general insurance statute, with some modifications. Modifications include requiring carriers to provide a policy summary document, which will be designed by the Department of Regulatory Agencies (DORA).

State Expenditures

Workload will minimally increase in DORA in FY 2024-25 to design the summary document and update discourse rules as necessary. This can be accomplished within existing resources.

Effective Date

This bill was signed into law by the Governor and took effect on May 31, 2024.
