#### **Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

The bill includes an appropriation clause that appropriates \$333,333 General Fund to the Department of Higher Education for FY 2042-25 for use by History Colorado, and makes any unexpended amount avialable for expenditure through FY 2025-26 for the same purpose. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department will require an additional 2.0 FTE.

#### **Points to Consider**

### General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee (JBC) has proposed a budget package for FY 2024-25 based on the March 2024 Office of State Planning and Budgeting revenue forecast. The JBC has included as part of its FY 2024-25 budget package \$333,333 General Fund to be appropriated for implementation of this bill.

In addition to the General Fund appropriation for FY 2024-26, the bill states the intent that the General Assembly provide General Fund appropriations of \$333,333 in FY 2025-26 and \$333,333 in FY 2026-27, reducing General Fund available for other purposes.
