**Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause.

**Description of Amendments in This Packet**

**J.001** Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating a total of \$153,104 General Fund to the Department of Labor and Employment for FY 2024-25. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department

will require an additional 1.4 FTE.

**L.002 and J.002**

Bill Sponsor amendment **L.002** (attached) directs the Department to work with a specific kind of organization to implement the bill and sets out requirements for how that organization will interact with Transportation Network Companies to implement this bill. Staff has prepared amendment **J.002** (attached) to add a provision appropriating a total of \$164,741 General Fund to the Department of Labor and Employment for FY 2024-25. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department will require an additional 1.5 FTE.

**If the Committee adopts L.002, it should also adopt J.002 and should NOT adopt J.001.**

**Points to Consider**

*General Fund Impact*

The Joint Budget Committee has proposed a budget package for FY 2024-25 based on the March 2024 Office of State Planning and Budgeting (OSPB) revenue forecast. The budget package includes \$93.5 million in set-asides for legislation outside of the package (see table below). The budget package accounts for the 15.0 percent reserve associated with the placeholders (a total of \$14.0 million).

This bill, as amended by the Business, Labor, and Technology Committee Report (02/20/24), requires a General Fund appropriation of \$153,104 for FY 2024-25, reducing the \$93.5 million set aside by the same amount.

If **L.002** is adopted, this bill will require a General Fund appropriation of \$164,741 for FY 2024-25, reducing the \$93.5 million set aside by the same amount.
