Description of Amendments in This Packet

J.001 Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating a total of \$182,571 General Fund for FY 2024-25, including \$87,326 to the Department of Labor and Employment and \$95,245 to the Department of Higher Education. The provision also reappropriates \$95,245 to the Department of Higher EducationThis provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department of Labor and Employment

will require an additional 0.8 FTE.

L.003 Bill Sponsor amendment **L.003** (attached) authorizes the use of a limited purpose fee-for-service contract with the community college system for funding for this program.

Points to Consider

General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee (JBC) is developing a budget package for FY 2024-25. This bill requires a General Fund appropriation of \$182,571 for FY 2024-25, reducing the General Fund available for other FY 2024-25 appropriations by this amount.
