L.003 Bill Sponsor amendment **L.003** (attached) reduces the amount that the General Assembly shall annually appropriate from the General Fund to the Gamete Agency, Gamete Bank, or Fertility Clinic Fund from \$229,335 to \$125,000. This appropriation does not occur until FY

Although this bill would not require a General Fund appropriation for FY 2024-25, it is projected to require a General Fund appropriation of \$229,335 in FY 2025-26.
