	The bill restricts the sale of counterfeit, unsafe, or novelty lighters. It minimally increases state expenditures starting in FY 2024-25.		
Appropriation Summary:	No appropriation is required.		
Fiscal Note Status:	The fiscal note reflects the introduced bill.		
The bill prohibits the sale of counterfeit, unsafe, or novelty lighters on a retail basis, wholesale basis, online, or in person. It does not prohibit the interstate transportation or warehouse storage of counterfeit, unsafe, or novelty lighters.  State Expenditures			
Starting in FY 2024-25, the bill may increase workload in the Department of Law from increased consumer complaints. The department will review complaints under the bill and prioritize			
investigations as necessary within the overall number of complaints and available resources.			
<b>Effective Date</b>			
The bill takes effect December 1, 2024, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
