Bill Topic:	CLARIFYING ENVIRONMENTAL RESPONSE SURCHARGE		
Summary of Fiscal Impact:	No fiscal impact. The bill clarifies when the environmental response surcharge is collected. It is assessed as having no fiscal impact on state and local governments.

Fiscal Note Status:	The fiscal note reflects the introduced bill, which was recommended by the Statutory Revision Committee.		

Summary of Legislation

The bill clarifies when the environmental response surcharge is collected based on available cash fund balance, and it repeals obsolete provisions.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

The bill resolves a minor statutory ambiguity, but does not change the operation of Petroleum Storage Tank Fund nor change the amount of money available. This results in no change to state or local government revenue or expenditures. For this reason, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect 90 days following adjournment of the General Assembly sine die, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
