Bill Topic: EVALUATION PROTECTIONS & EDUCATORS

No fiscal impact. The bill extends the confidentiality of evaluation reports and related records to all teachers, principals, administrators, special service providers, and education support professionals. The bill does not change the revenue or expenses of school districts or state agencies and is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Status:

Summary of Legislation

Under current law, an evaluation report and the records used to prepare the performance evaluation of a licensed professional in public education are confidential and available only to the licensed personnel being evaluated, to the person's supervisors, or to the courts reviewing a decision of a local board of education. This bill extends the confidentiality of evaluation reports and records to all teachers, principals, administrators, special service providers, and education support professionals.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

Under current law, personnel records, including evaluations, for licensed education personnel are confidential. Expanding the confidentiality provisions to include specified educators, administrators, and support professionals is not anticipated to functionally change the operations of the school district personnel performance evaluation processes or rules. The bill will not impact the revenue or expenditures of any state agency or school district. For these reasons, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect 90 days following adjournment of the General Assembly sine die, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
